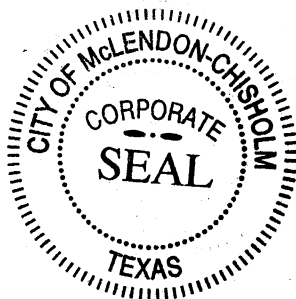
5. RECOVER OPEN SESSION FOR POSSIBLE ACTION FROM EXECUTIVE SESSION


6. ADJOURN
